DECISION OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE OF THE CENTRAL EUROPEAN FREE TRADE AGREEMENT, CEFTA 2006

Decision No 2/2007 Adopted on 28 September 2007

Establishment of Sub Committees

The Joint Committee

Having regard to the Agreement on Amendment of and Accession to the Central European Free Trade Agreement, CEFTA 2006, done in Bucharest on 19 December 2006 (herein after called the "Agreement"),

Hereby establishes, pursuant to Article 41.5 to the Agreement, the following sub-committees:

- Sub-committee on Agriculture including Sanitary and Phytosanitary Issues
- Sub-committee on Customs and Rules of Origin, and
- Sub-committee on Technical Barriers to Trade and Non-Tariff Barriers

The sub-committees will follow the same procedures for the convening, documenting and reporting of meetings as set out in Rules of Procedure for the Joint Committee.

- 1. The above-mentioned sub-committees will work in accordance to the respective individual terms of reference agreed by the Joint Committee.
- 2. The Chair of each sub-committee shall rotate on a yearly basis in accordance with the alphabetical order of the Parties' names in English.
- 3. The Party currently acting as Chair in Office shall chair the Sub-committee on Agriculture including Sanitary and Phytosanitary Issues.
- 4. The Chair of the Sub-committee on Customs and Rules of Origin will be a representative of the first party in alphabetical order after the Chair in Office.
- 5. The Chair of the Sub-committee on Technical Barriers to Trade and Non-Tariff Barriers will be a representative of the second party in alphabetical order after the Chair in Office.
- 6. Meetings of each sub-committee shall take place in the Party holding the Chair of the respective sub-committee.

This decision shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
