

**DECISION OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE OF THE CENTRAL EUROPEAN
FREE TRADE AGREEMENT, CEFTA 2006**

**Decision No 6/2007
Adopted on 28 September 2007**

Establishment of a List of Mediators

The Joint Committee

Having regard to the Agreement on Amendment of and Accession to the Central European Free Trade Agreement, CEFTA 2006, done in Bucharest on 19 December 2006 (herein after called the "Agreement"),

Hereby agrees, pursuant to Article 41.6 to the Agreement, to establish a commonly agreed List of Mediators.

To this end, each Party will forward to the Chair in Office the names and contact details of at least three officials who have experience with UNCITRAL Conciliation Rules and international trade rules including those of the WTO and can be considered qualified to act as mediators in line with the conditions specified in Article 42.3 to the Agreement.

Parties will submit these names by 30 November 2007 so that the Chair can establish a commonly agreed List of Mediators before the end of 2007.

This decision shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
